Principals Report

It was a great pleasure to see all of the teachers working together to ensure that all of our students had the opportunity to continue their learning no matter where they were. Throughout the challenges we faced, our teachers continued to work diligently, sometimes way out of their comfort zone with regards to the use of technology, and delivered an excellent array of learning experiences, which could be completed no matter where the learning was taking place. I want to take this opportunity to publicly thank all of the teachers, office staff, executive and learning support personnel for the care they showed to all the students and to each other in an extraordinary time. As our year gets back to a bit of normality our attention turns to our regular school activities that happen at this time of year. This is later than normal to allow time for teachers to work with the changes made by the Department of Education.

Secondly, starting next term, we will begin to see students engaged in more sporting activities. Packing an everyday lunchbox does not have to contain fancy ingredients.


Make packing an everyday lunchbox easy by adding:

The goal is to give students the best possible chance to make positive choices, with every teacher using consistent and shared language along the way.
